**Ordinance 2019- 05**

**An Ordinance to Amend the Redfield Municipal Code,  
Declaring an Emergency; and for other purposes;**

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Redfield Arkansas has determined that the Redfield Municipal Code is in need of amending; and

Whereas, this ordinance is necessary for the efficient operations of the city government;

Now, therefore be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Redfield, Arkansas; That the Redfield Municipal Code is amended as follows;

**Section (1).** Section 12.04.01 (*Ordinance 85-4, Section 1*), is repealed and amended with the following;

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Redfield shall have exclusive authority and responsibility in all operations of all City parks and recreation areas owned by the city of Redfield Arkansas.

**Section (2)** Section 12.04.02 (*Ordinance 85-2, Section 2*), is repealed and amended with following;

The Mayor and City Council of City of Redfield shall have exclusive responsibility in all operations of all public parks and recreation areas owned by the City of Redfield, and to make purchases of all supplies, equipment, materials, and other things requisite for public purposes in and for the operations of city parks and recreation areas, and to make all necessary contracts for use, maintenance, repair, addition, upgrade, work and / or labor to be done ,or material or other necessary things for the benefit of the city parks and recreation areas, or in carrying out any work or undertaking of any public nature in any city park and recreation area.

**Section (3)** Section 12.04.03 (*Ordinance 2008-5, Sections 1 and 2, Ordinance 85-4 Section 3*),  
Section 12.04.04 (*Ordinance 85-4, Section 4*) and,  
Section 12.04.05 (*Ordinance 85-4, Section5*) of the Redfield Municipal Code is repealed.

**Section (4).** Section 12.08.04 (*Ordinance 88-1, Section 4*) is repealed and amended with the following;

All persons, firms or corporations desiring to sell, trade, barter, or exchange any commodity, article, or thing, of any nature, within the limits of any public park or recreation area, must submit a written request to the office of the Mayor and receive written permission from the office of the Mayor prior to said sale, barter, or exchange of said commodity, article, or thing.

**Section (5).** Section 12.08.11 (*Ordinance 88-1, Section 11*) is repealed and amended with the following;

Hours of use for any public parks and recreation areas shall be from 6:00 am to 11:00 pm. Hours of use for any public park and recreation area may be modified, altered, or extended by the office of the Mayor and / or City Council when deemed appropriate.

**Section (6)** Section 12.08.14 (*Ordinance 2012-14, Section 1*) is repealed and amended with the following;

It shall be unlawful to operate any ATV, UTV, off-road motorcycle, or any other off-road vehicle in a public park or recreation area, except when authorized by the office of the Mayor and/ or City Council. This shall not apply to the use of off-road vehicles by City of Redfield departments or employees, Law Enforcement, Fire Department or other emergency personnel, while in the performance of official business or duties.

**Section (7)** Section 12.08.15 (*Ordinance 2012-14, Section 3*) is repealed and amended with the following;

It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any firearm including air guns, BB guns, pellet guns, or any archery equipment in any public park or recreation area, unless the person is a certified law enforcement officer acting in the line of duty or the person is competing in an event authorized and approved by the Office of the Mayor and/ or City Council.


**Section (8).** All Ordinances, Resolutions, Regulations, or parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section (9).** The provisions of this Ordinances are declared severable, and if the provisions shall for any reason be illegal or invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

**Section (10).** Emergency Clause:

This ordinance, being necessary for the protection and the preservation of the Public Peace, Safety, and Welfare, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force on the date of its passage.

**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-06**

**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REZONING OF CERTAIN TERRITORY IN THE CITY OF REDFIELD, AR  
(800 Block of Sheridan Road)**

**WHEREAS**, The City of Redfield Planning Commission held a public hearing on Thursday, August 1st, 2019, as provided for in Section 6, Act 186 of the Statutes of the State of Arkansas, the purpose of which was to hear any and all persons interested in amending the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Redfield by providing for the rezoning of certain property; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been expressly stated by the City Council of the City of Redfield that the Zoning Ordinance should be amended to provide for the rezoning of said property,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDFIELD,  
ARKANSAS**

**SECTION 1.**

That the following described property be and the same is hereby established and defined C-2, General Commercial for all future purpose as set forth and defined in the Zoning Ordinance.

Beg at a point in the NW SW Section of 22-3-11 being located at the intersection of the centerline of Sheridan Road and Morman Street; thence north along the centerline of Morman Street 150 feet +/- for a point of beginning (said point also being the intersection of the centerline of Morman Street and the existing C-2 zoning boundary); thence north 210 feet; thence east 410 feet +/- to the existing C-2 zoning boundary; thence southwesterly along said zoning line approximately 450 feet to the point of beginning.

**SECTION 2.**

That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict.

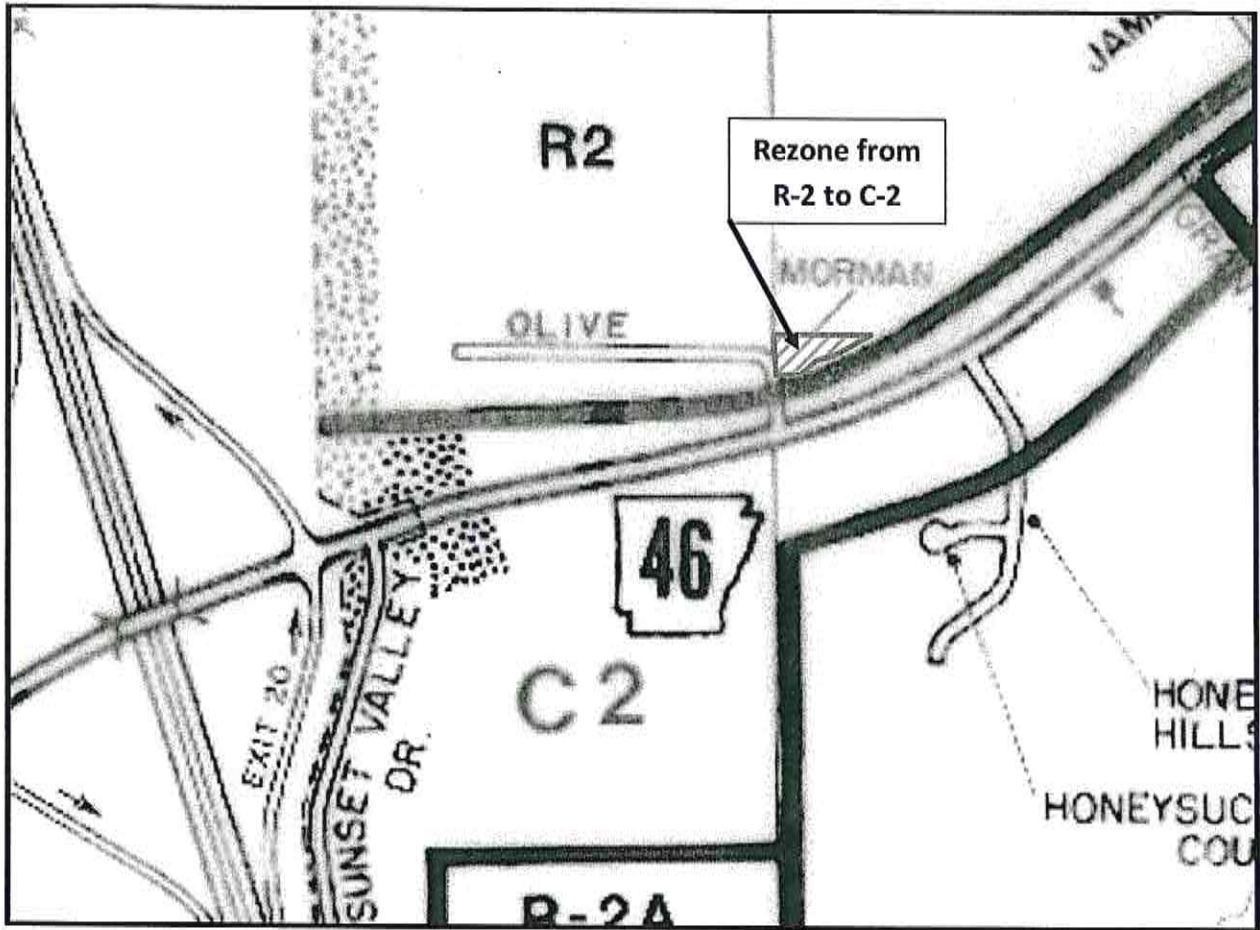
**SECTION 3**
