Ordinance 2019- 03

**An Ordinance to Amend the Redfield Municipal Code,
Title 3, Section 3.08.022, Declaring an Emergency;
and for other purposes;**

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Redfield Arkansas has determined that the Redfield Municipal Code is in need of amending for the efficient operations of the City government, and;

Whereas, this ordinance is necessary for the efficient operations of the city government;

Now, therefore be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Redfield, Arkansas; That the Redfield Municipal Code Title 3 is amended as follows;

Section (1). Section 3.08.02 of the Redfield Municipal Code is amended as follows.

Section (2). Specific purchases and contracts.

(a) The governing body of a city of Redfield Arkansas may purchase the following commodities without soliciting bids:

- (1) Motor fuels, oil, asphalt, asphalt oil, and natural gas; and
- (2) New motor vehicles from a motor vehicle dealer licensed under the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission Act, §23-112-101 et seq., if the motor vehicle is purchased for an amount not to exceed the fleet price awarded by the Office of State Procurement and in effect at the time the City submits the purchase order for the same make and model motor vehicle.

(3) Law Enforcement or Fire Fighting vehicles.

(b) The City Council of the City of Redfield Arkansas may renew or extend the term of an existing contract without soliciting bids.

Section (3). Purchases and Contracts Generally

- (a) The Mayor of the City of Redfield or ~~his~~ a duly authorized representative of the Mayor, shall have exclusive power and responsibility to make purchases of all supplies, apparatus, equipment, materials, and other things requisite for public purposes in and for the city, and to make all necessary contracts for work or labor to be done, or material or other necessary things to be furnished for the benefit of the city, or in carrying out any work or undertaking of a public nature in the city.
- (b) The Mayor of the City of Redfield Arkansas, or ~~his or her~~ a duly authorized representative of the Mayor, must notify and receive authorization from the City Council prior to the expenditure for any purpose or contract that exceeds the sum of ~~\$2,000.00~~, \$20,000.

Section (4). All Ordinances, Resolutions, Regulations, or parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section (5). The provisions of this Ordinances are declared severable, and if the provisions shall for any reason be illegal or invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section (6). Emergency Clause:

This ordinance being necessary for the protection and the preservation of the Public Peace, Safety, Welfare, and the efficient operations of City Government, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force on the date of its passage.

Ordinance 2019-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REDFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE; REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Redfield, Arkansas has determined that the safety of our levies requires certain modifications and posting;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDFIELD, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Weight Limit on Harvey CT

No vehicle having a capacity of eight (8) tons or more may use Harvey CT except for school bus use, public safety, or an emergency. Emergency is defined as an unexpected and unusually dangerous situation that calls for immediate action.

Section 2. No Parking on Harvey CT

No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle on Harvey CT except where necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic-control device.

As to any vehicle parking in violation when the driver is not present, it shall be presumed the owner parked the same, or that the driver was acting as an agent of the owner.

Section 3. Weight Limit on Baugh Drive.

No vehicle having a capacity of eight (8) tons or more may use Baugh Drive except for school bus use, public safety, or an emergency. Emergency is defined as an unexpected and unusually dangerous situation that calls for immediate action.

Section 4. Fine

Any person violating this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), and each occurrence of violation will constitute a separate offense.

Section 5. All Ordinances, Resolutions, Regulations, or parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable, and if the provisions shall for any reason be illegal or invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 7. There is an immediate need to adopt this Ordinance. An emergency exists. Heavy trucks are in danger of damaging the levies. This Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, it shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage and approval.
